

MODERN APPRENTICESHIP COORDINATORS' EVENT:

KEY CHANGES AHEAD



ETITO is holding three forums in February for Modern Apprenticeship Coordinators [MACs] to keep them up-to-date with key changes taking place this year.

Modern Apprenticeship Coordinators play an essential part in industry training and the forums are designed to ensure they are equipped and supported to best perform their role.

Updates will cover the Tertiary Education Commission's new online Industry Training Register and what this will mean for MACs and reporting.

MACs will also be updated on ETITO facilitating literacy and numeracy assessment for all new trainees at Levels 2 and 3 using the online Literacy and Numeracy for Adults Assessment Tool.

Industry Manager Electrotechnology Paul Hollings will give an overview on the health of the electrotechnology and telecommunications industries and its likely impact on training numbers over the next 12 to 24 months.

The forums will also cover changes to the Training Agreement process, including new prerequisites to support funding criteria and performance.
