

ETITO securing modular and full course training provision for financial advisers

ETITO, in conjunction with the New Zealand Qualifications Authority [NZQA], has lifted the moratorium on the accreditation of training providers interested in delivering training in the financial services industry.

This follows NZQA approval of changes made to the ETITO quality assurance system for financial services unit standards, required by the Securities Commission. The new statement of ETITO's quality assurance requirements is published on the NZQA website and available below.

With the lifting of the moratorium, ETITO is now actively encouraging universities, polytechnics and private training providers to contact ETITO if they are interested in contributing to a nationwide network of modular and full course training provision for thousands of financial advisers that may require training prior to December 2010 when the Financial Advisers Act comes into effect.
