It was also an opportune time for them to find out more about the National Certificate in Financial Services [Level 4] and the National Certificate in Financial Advice [Level 5] that have been referenced in the recently released Securities Commission discussion document on authorised financial adviser competence.

The sessions also covered the principles of industry training, the purpose and structure of unit standards and national qualifications and how workplace assessment can occur.
