



QUALIFICATION REVIEW – ELECTRONIC SECURITY LEVEL 3 AND LEVEL 4

As the national standard setting body for the electronic security industry ETITO is required to review the existing qualifications and standards to ensure they remain current and/or fit for purpose.

ETITO works in partnership with industry to carry out such review processes.

We are about to begin the review process for the National Certificate in Electronic Security Level 3 and Level 4 and the associated unit standards that sit within these qualifications.

ETITO is now seeking expressions of interest from people who would like to be a part of the proposed consultation group, contributing their knowledge and expertise to help inform the shape and content of the qualification. By participating you will take an active part in ensuring the continuing relevance for the training packages for this sector.

Anticipated development process:

- A maximum of four one-day meetings held at ETITO offices in Auckland and Wellington [video conference linked to Auckland].
- Approximately 1-2 days of individual work between meetings sharing information within your own networks, and gathering feedback to bring back to the group.
