



NATIONAL CERTIFICATE IN ELECTRONIC SECURITY [LEVEL 4]

National Certificate in Electronic Security [Level 4]

This qualification follows on from the National Certificate in Electronic Security [Installer] [Level 3].

The compulsory section provides knowledge and skills to an advanced level, including:

- Knowledge of electronic security systems and equipment functions.
- Design of electronic security access control systems
- Design of electronic security intruder alarm systems
- Commission and hand-over integrated electronic security systems.

The elective section allows you to select appropriate skills for your role in the electronics industry [a minimum of one standard is required]. These unit standards include:

- Manage and/or supervise workplace operations
- Design electronic security intercom systems
- Design electronic security CCTV systems
